

Properties Of Liquids

A **liquid** is a state of matter that can flow and can take the shape of its container. Liquids can be described by their properties of **color**, **texture** and **viscosity**.

Color – Liquids can be any color or colorless.

Texture – Liquids can feel sticky, gooey, slippery, or watery to the touch.

Viscosity – Viscosity is the resistance to flow. We can see and feel the viscosity of a liquid when we watch it flow or try to stir it. Thick liquids tend to be more viscous, while thin liquids tend to be less viscous.
