Place your rain gauge in an open area away from trees and structures that may cause inaccurate rainfall readings.

This chart keeps track of 24 hour rainfall totals. Choose a time every day that you can consistently check and record the rainfall amounts. If you have breakfast at the same time each day, that might be a great time to check your gauge. Just be sure that your readings are as close to 24 hours apart as possible so your records will be accurate.

After collecting your rainfall amounts, you might want to graph them daily, weekly, or monthly.
